The term "Charity Pool Exhibitions", "Sport Exhibitions Ltd", "us" or "we" refers to the owner of the website whose registered office is 108 Weston Road, Meir, Stoke on Trent, ST3 6AL. Our company registration number is 5556320. The term "you" refers to the user, viewer and clients of our website and/or business.

1. General Terms & Conditions

Charity Pool Exhibitions is a name used by Sport Exhibitions Limited and is a Professional Fundraising Organisations (PFO) raising funds for charities. Our costs are covered by the funds the company raises. All costs such equipment, office expenses, accommodation, food, volunteer's expenses, professional fees, vehicles, insurances, wages, and capital are met by the company.

All funds raised are deposited into the charity's accounts direct and the charity is invoiced on a monthly basis for expenses incurred. On an annual basis, we must provide our accounts to the charities along with receipts if so requested.

Our accounts are registered with Companies House and available through the proper channels.

Anyone who fundraises in return for a service provided by us agree that;

- 1.1. all funds raised will be deposited directly into the chosen charity account, except where it is agreed that a representative of the company or chosen charity may take the cash, with a receipt provided.
- 1.2. part of the funds raised will go towards covering the cost of the company providing the service.
- 1.3. we are responsible for all aspects of the service we provide and that all correspondence and/or tasks should be met by us to prevent any costs being incurred by the chosen charity.

Anyone who does not agree with this is welcome to fundraise for the charities we support direct, but no services will be provided by us.

2. Pre-Determined Events

When you book a pre-determined event, you agree to the following conditions:

- 2.1. Deposits paid to Sport Exhibitions Limited are fully refundable once the agreed fundraising targets have been met and banked into the specified charity account no later than 30 days after the event date.

If point 2.1 is not met, all or part of the deposit will not be returned, depending on the amounts banked as per below;

- 2.1.1. If the shortfall is equal to, or greater than the deposit, 100% of the deposit will be retained.
- 2.1.2. If the shortfall is less than the deposit, then an amount equal to the shortfall will be retained and the balance of the deposit returned, minus a £20.00 administration fee.
- 2.2. Any funds raised and/or banked is non-refundable regardless of whether the event goes ahead or not if the terms have been broken. In the case of Sport Exhibitions Ltd or the charity cancelling the event then deposits are fully refundable.
- 2.3. In the case of a cancelled event -----All funds raised but not yet banked must be deposited into the charity's account regardless of whether the event goes ahead or not
- 2.4. An event's date will only be confirmed upon receipt of a deposit or in the case of no deposit being paid, then 25% of the fundraising target must be raised and banked.
- 2.5. 75% of the fundraising target must be raised and banked three days prior to the event taking place.

- 2.6. 100% of the fundraising target must be raised and banked no later than thirty days after the event has taken place.
- 2.7. In the case of further deposits being required due to an insufficient percentage of the fundraising target being reached, the terms and conditions as per point two (2) applies. However, it may be agreed on a case by case basis to allow an extension of to raise the balance and for the further deposits to be returned as per our terms.
